The Choctaw United Methodist Men have set the date for the 2019 Ron Brown Memorial Golf Tournament. Our four-person scramble is scheduled for Saturday, May 18, with a shotgun start at 1 p.m. and a dinner immediately following the conclusion of the tournament. The tournament is a major fundraiser for the United Methodist Men (UMM) and helps us to send local youth to church camp, perform mission projects, and support numerous other events benefiting the Choctaw community.
